The fast-food business is on the verge of making a massive change in its drive-thru with a new type of restaurant design.

Taco Bell has designed a restaurant that is drive-thru exclusive that caters to cars and 3rd- party delivery apps such as Grubhub and Doordash. Customers want contactless delivery due to Covid-19, which the restaurant is designed to provide.

Covid-19 has changed the fast food industry immensely. Restaurants want to keep dine-in areas closed since they can save money and time on cleaning. Restaurants want to cater to drive-thru customers because they are more valuable than dine-in customers. Fast-food restaurants such as Wendy's are opening up "ghost kitchens" to help expand their delivery and business according to *INSIDER*.

"Ghost Kitchens are commercial kitchens optimized for food delivery. Each kitchen is located in areas with a high concentration of delivery demand. The kitchens themselves don't have a storefront and the staff prepares dishes off of their menus that are only available for delivery." as defined by *Cloud Kitchens*.

Ghost kitchens have been on the rise, working in the background helping large

corporations and other businesses make orders. A famous ghost kitchen is "MrBeast Burger" started by internet sensation Mr. Beast. Mr. Beast uses a virtual app to take orders and then a nearby ghost kitchen can prepare the order and a 3rd party delivery app can deliver the order, and Taco Bell is using this to their advantage.

The new design for Taco Bell elevates a ghost kitchen with drive-thru lanes running underneath eliminating the need for dine-in areas. The ghost kitchen will be able to work efficiently without the worry of dine-in customers.

Ghost kitchens will be able to work for multiple corporations, so they will be able to work through the whole day preparing multiple orders. If the kitchen takes on more than they can chew, then they can add a second story to the building to help with the extra orders.

Consumers are ordering more takeout than ever before. Restaurant Business states, "Twenty-two percent of consumers now say that ordering food for carryout or delivery is more a part of their routine than it was two years ago, according to Technomic." Consumers are getting carryout more now than ever since it is easier for them.

DoorDash, UberEats, and Postmates have seen a 204% increase in revenue since 2015 according to Business of Apps. They are expected to make \$42 billion in revenue by 2025. Not only restaurants are using 3rd party delivery apps, but meal prep and household items

are also being delivered. Amazon Fresh offers delivery on groceries and everyday essentials, and other corporations will soon follow this trend.

Corporations can also follow the same style of distribution as Taco Bell is planning to do because it is cost-effective and easy to do for the companies. Soon, we may see these new types of restaurants, and soon after that groceries stores doing the same thing.



Since then, the character has become the face of Disney with dozens of films and TV shows made around the character. The films and shows included other celebrated characters like Minnie Mouse, Donald Duck, and Goofy.

A more recent iconic character is Spongebob Squarepants. The character is the protagonist of his titular show that has aired since 1999 and has run for thirteen seasons on Nickelodeon.

Spongebob Squarepants is among one of the longest running animated shows of all time. It has even adapted three films, The Spongebob Squarepants in 2004, The Movie Spongebob Squarepants Movie Sponge Out of Water in 2015, and The Spongebob Squarepants Movie Sponge on the Run in 2020. It features some of the most iconic characters such as Squidward, Mr. Krabs, and Patrick Star, who has his own self focused show titled The Patrick Star Show.

In 1969, Scooby-Doo made his first appearance in the animated show *Scooby-Doo Where Are You*. The show followed the pair and their three friends, Fred Jones, Daphne Blake, and Velma Dinkley, as they solve mysteries. It has since adapted multiple reboots of the show, multiple animated films, and two

live action films, *Scooby Doo and Scooby Doo 2 Monsters Unleashed*, released in 2002 and 2004 respectively.

In 1987, the world was introduced to the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles, consisting of the characters Leonardo, Michelangelo, Donatello, and Raphael. The characters became beloved classics immediately when they were released. The characters have continued to play a part in pop culture and have been adapted into live action shows, more cartoon shows, and multiple live action and animated films.

The website Hollywood Reporter recently wrote an article titled "Why 'Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles' is Radical 30 Years Later". This is true due to the many films and reboots that have been released. The most notable films include Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles, Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles 3, and two live action remakes, titled Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles and Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles Out of the Shadows.

How Technological Advancements Have Helped Society Deal With Covid-19

Technological advancements have helped society deal with the effects of Covid-19 ever since the start of the pandemic. The usage of supercomputers to help get the genetic information of the Sars-COV-2 virus as well as the shift over to grocery and food delivery via third-party apps such as Door Dash and Uber Eats shows us how the pandemic has forced humanity to shift more towards contactless options for a lot of what society does.

As an example, DoorDash, a food delivery company based in San Francisco, has helped provide contactless-delivery services for companies to ensure people can get fast food without having to leave their homes.

Because of the current impacts of the pandemic, DoorDash has seen staggering growth.

The Motley Fool, a website that advises people on stocks they should buy, reported, "...the company's total orders increased by a stunning 219% year over year while its revenue skyrocketed 198% to \$1.08 billion over the same period. Meanwhile, its stock price is up 50% from its IPO last December."

Rivaling DoorDash, Uber Eats has also seen significant revenue growth over the course of the pandemic.

Business of Apps, a site that reports on the successes and failures of certain apps, reported, "Uber Eats generated \$4.8 billion in revenue in 2020, a 152 percent increase year-on-year"

As you can assume, Uber Eats is

competing with DoorDash. However, as of now, DoorDash seems to be winning with a 198 percent increase in revenue versus a 152 percent increase in revenue with Uber Eats.

Another example of technology helping with the pandemic is with supercomputing.

VentureBeat, a site that reports on technology, stated, "In separate efforts, AWS is empowering researchers at the Children's National Hospital to combine hundreds of data sets to identify genes that might be targeted to treat COVID-19."

Supercomputing was imperative to developing the current vaccines for Covid-19 as it has helped find the genetic code of Covid-19.

A particularly innovative ecommerce firm, Mirakl, is helping medical organizations get the supplies they need by allowing them to communicate with organizations to ensure they can get the equipment they need.

Weforum.org, an online forum, reported, "...without clear lines of communication it might not get to the hospitals when, and where, it's most needed."

The efforts to rid the world of Covid-19 do not stop there. Wearable technology company, Oura, is helping out as well.

Techrepublic.com states, "As part of the study, the company has donated more than 2,000 Oura Rings to collect body temperature, heart rate and other health data to identify contraction of the coronavirus early on."

One of the more minor things that Covid-19 has affected is verbal communication.

VoaNews reported, "The mask is made of soft plastic material and contains a built-in microphone. When it is turned on, the mask uses Bluetooth technology to connect to a mobile device." Although addressing a minor problem, it is an innovative solution.

Although drones are usually used for recreational purposes, they can also be used to help with Covid-19.

Globaldata.com showed, "These drones are equipped with cameras to provide updates on the ground condition and also identify individuals who don't comply with the lockdown norms as well." This helps a lot to ensure the people you care about are following Covid-19 recommendations.

Drones are not only being used to see who is social distancing. They are also being used to sanitize large buildings.

Dronelife.com stated, "Using EPA-approved chemicals, the disinfectant drones can spray over large facilities such as stadiums and ballparks, or indoor buildings such as jails and government offices." Another handy gadget that is becoming a norm in the midst of Covid-19 is handsfree door openers.

Weforum.org reports, "Some door-opening devices have already found their way to market – including the "hygiene hook", created by London-

I said," I think I've had enough Halloween for a while."



Afghanistan: Warring for Decades

Afghanistan has been the center of attention over recent months and even years due to the tumultuous history of the region and its lack of a stable government.

In 1921, Afghanistan gained its independence from England after WWI and was formally recognized by the United States in 1934. At this time

Afghanistan was a monarchy under King Zahir Shah; he started the longest period of stable rule in Afghanistan to date (forty years).

In 1973, pro-Soviet military general Mohammed Daoud Khan led a military coup and overthrew the current government. Twenty-Two years later in the midst of an Afghan civil-war a new militant group (The Taliban) rises to power with the promise of peace while also upholding traditional Islamic values.

After 1995 when the Taliban took power, they began to enforce their very strict version of Islamic law across the country and enforce harsh punishments, sparking an outcry from human rights organizations around the world.

In 1999, two years before 9/11, the UN imposed sanctions on Afghanistan due to their unwillingness to help quell terrorism in the region.

On September 11, 2001 the World Trade Center was attacked and the United States asked the Taliban to give them Osama Bin Laden. When they refused, the United States decided to invade, and on October 7, 2001, the United States started their invasion.

By the start of 2002, the Taliban had been completely overthrown and driven out of Afghanistan. In 2006, there was a brief Taliban reemergence where they claimed territory in southern Afghanistan, but they were quickly pushed out.

On May 2, 2011 U.S forces killed

Al-Qaeda leader Osama Bin Laden in Pakistan after chasing him all throughout the region since the 9/11 attacks on the United States.


In May of 2014, then President Barack Obama announced a plan to significantly reduce U.S troops in Afghanistan by 2016. In December of the same year, NATO officially ended its combat operations in Afghanistan and the United States took over training Afghan troops.

In October of 2015, Obama abandoned his plan to withdraw all troops in Afghanistan by the end of his presidency and left 5,500 troops in Afghanistan when he left office.

Until 2018, things were relatively calm in the region. President Donald Trump appointed Zalmay Khalilzad to negotiate with the Taliban and in February 2019 the U.S and Taliban signed a preliminary that said the United States would withdraw all forces by May of 2021.

In September of 2019, the United States pulled out of peace talks with the Taliban after a United States soldier was killed in a Taliban attack which once again caused tensions to rise in the region.

On September 11, 2021 the United States officially withdrew all troops from Afghanistan and the Taliban immediately moved back causing one of the biggest humanitarian crises in modern history, resulting in the United States evacuating more than 120,000 people between the dates of August 14-31 according to White House. gov.




