After Taylor Swift made her first appearance at a Kansas City Chiefs' game back in September, Taylor's presence was immediately captured by the NFL. Of course, this came to be about due to her at the time rumored relationship with the Chiefs tight end, Travis Kelce. Taylor Swift's economic impact was shown very early on when Travis Kelce jersey sales went up by 400% within a week of Taylor's first appearance. Taylor hasn't just helped with sales, but with viewership as well. The 2023 regular season game averaged 17.9 million in viewership which is 7% higher than last year's numbers.

Taylor, in 2023, had an extreme economic impact with her tour, making over 10 billion dollars. Then in October, she made the AMC stock increase by 10% following the release of her tour documentary. Now, with the Super Bowl, Swift is sure to make even more money for the NFL.

Super Bowl 58: Kansas City Chiefs vs San Francisco 49ers

On February 11th, 2024, Reigning Super Bowl champions, the Kansas City Chiefs, took on the San Francisco 49ers at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas, Nevada.

The Kansas City Chiefs, led by quarterback Patrick Mahomes and tight end Travis Kelce, saw a record of 11-6 through the regular season, clinching the 3 seed in the AFC. Their path to the Super Bowl consisted of a home game versus the Miami Dolphins and two away games versus the Buffalo Bills and the Baltimore Ravens.

The San Francisco 49ers, led by quarterback Brock Purdy and running back Christian McCaffery, saw a record of 12-4 in the regular season, clinching the 1 seed of the NFC. Their path to the Super Bowl consisted of two home games against the Green Bay Packers and Detroit Lions.

Super Bowl 58 kicked off and

saw a quiet first quarter with no points for either team. The score stayed 0-0 until early in the second quarter, when 49ers kicker Jake Moody would score a Super Bowl-record 55-yard field goal. Ten minutes later, a 49ers trick play led to wide receiver Jauan Jennings throwing a 10-yard touchdown pass to Christian McCaffery, giving the 49ers a 10-0 lead.

The Chiefs would not answer back until 20 seconds remained in the first half when Chiefs kicker Harrison Butker scored a 28-yard field goal and sent the game to halftime with a score of 10-3.

The annual Super Bowl Halftime Show was hosted by Usher, who performed some of his most popular songs, such as "Caught Up," "Burn," "Turn Down for What," and many more.

The game would resume in the 3rd quarter, and both teams traded possessions until Harrison Butker broke the Super Bowl record. With a 57-yard field goal, the score became 10-6, favoring the 49ers.

Just 3 minutes later, Patrick Mahomes would lead the Chiefs into the endzone with a passing touchdown to wide receiver Marquez Valdez-Scantling, giving the Chiefs their first lead of the game at 13-10.

The 4th quarter saw the most scoring action of the entire game, starting with a touchdown pass from Brock Purdy to Jauan Jennings. However, Jake Moody's PAT (point after touchdown) attempt was blocked, making the score 16-13.

Both teams traded field goals, and as the clock ticked down, the Chiefs turned to Harrison Butker to send the game into overtime with a score of 19-19.

The 49ers received the first possession of overtime and only managed to score a field goal, giving the Chiefs the ball with 7 minutes remaining. The Chiefs would use the rest of the time. marching down the field, and as time expired, Patrick Mahomes found Mecole Hardman in the endzone for the walk-off touchdown, winning Super Bowl 58.

Mahomes was crowned Super Bowl MVP for the 3rd time in his career.

Super Bowl 58 was extra special to Hickman County. This is because Zan Brendel, the wife of San Francisco 49ers center, Jake Brendel, graduated from Hickman County High School with the Class of 2013 and attended the Super Bowl in Las Vegas with her mother who lives in Hickman County.

The Evolution of Video Games

Video games are one of the most popular hobbies. As of 2023, there are 2.7 billion gamers in the world, which equals 33.5%. Nearly everyone has played a video game at least once in their lives, whether it be an arcade game or a PlayStation game.

Gaming is most popular among the 18-34 age group, accounting for 36% of the gaming population. At the same time, 24% of gamers are under the age of 18, while 13% are aged between 35 and 44.

The first video game was created in October 1958 by William Higinbotham. It was called *Tennis for Two*. The game only lasted for two years and did not

make much of an impact on popular culture but made a huge impact on video games and technology. Throughout the next decade, computer scientists worked to perfect video games.

The first home video game console, the Magnavox Odyssey, was released in 1972. The first game released with the console was called *Pong*. It is a simple virtual table tennis game that quickly became popular.

After the Magnavox, came the Atari 2600 in 1977. Nine games were created with it including *Air Sea Battle* and *Asteroids*.

In the late 1970s, arcades started becoming a part of pop culture. Created in 1978, *Space Invaders* was a huge phenomenon and people could save their scores on the game machine at the arcade. In 1980, the game was given a home video game release.

The 1980s was the biggest jump

in the video game industry. It has shaped gaming as it is today. Some of the most well known video game icons were developed, such as the Super Mario Brothers and Donkey Kong.

The gaming company Nintendo released their first console, Nintendo Entertainment System, in 1983 in Japan. It was later released worldwide in 1985 with the first ever Super Mario Brothers Game becoming the console's biggest game.

Nintendo continued to become one of the greatest gaming companies of all time, releasing both home consoles, such as the Nintendo Wii, and portable consoles, such as the Nintendo DS.

In the 1990s, a wider variety of gaming consoles became popular. As

computers became popular in everyday life, so did computer games. There had been past computer games, but they hadn't achieved success like it did

in the 1990s.

The content of games began to change in the early 90s. Video games started including more graphic violence, and it created controversy. The most well known was *Mortal Kombat*, an action adventure game released by the game company Midway in 1992.

Parents were upset about the violent content of the game and a year later the US Senate made the decision to create a game rating board. In 1994, the Entertainment Software Rating Board (ESRB) was established. The ratings today range from E for everyone to M for mature.

The PlayStation1 console was released in Japan in 1994 and worldwide in 1995. PlayStation took a while to gain the traction it has today. Some of the most acclaimed games included the *Final Fantasy* series and the *Resident Evil* series.

PlayStation1 was later followed by a series of four game consoles, the last, PlayStation5, being released in 2020.

In November 2001, the first XBox game system was made public. Before the end of 2001, the console had sold over 1.5 million units. Like other gaming consoles, they released a series of consoles with the latest, the XBox Series X and Series S, being released both in 2020.

XBox was the home console to many popular gaming series in the 2000s such as *Grand Theft Auto*, *Halo*, and *Call of Duty*.

Online games first began gaining attention in the 90s. In the 2000s, it became a main way people played video games. The first XBox console allowed people to start playing online in 2002. Online playing allowed people to play and chat with anyone in the world.

Video game streaming gained notoriety in the early 2010s. Streaming allowed people to watch gameplays of popular games. Some of the most streamed games included *Five Nights at Freddy's*, *Fortnite*, and *Minecraft*. Viewers could comment on how the players were doing. The most used live streaming platforms include Twitch and YouTube.

The biggest technological advance in games was the introduction of virtual reality, or VR. While VR has existed for years, it was never as advanced as it is now and continues to be. Renowned VR games include the rhythm game *Beat Saber* and simulation game *Job Simulator*.

The difference between the first video game and today's version is almost unimaginable. From a small table tennis game in the 1950s to the actual feeling of being in the game with VR, gaming will continue to evolve.

Bad Decisions Ruin Reputation and Profitability

Becoming a famous celebrity or household name in society is a feat that is hard to achieve but incredibly easy to throw away. The 21st century has seen its fair share of celebrities or other entities throwing their influence away with a single post or decision, with one sentence that gets leaked or revealed to the public online, an event that causes a fanbase to stop following a celebrity, or any other unfortunate event that the celebrity is not expecting.

In 2021, American rapper Jacques Bermon Webster II, known famously as Travis Scott, went on a concert tour of the United States in celebration of his album *Astroworld*. However, when Travis Scott returned to his hometown of Houston, Texas, for the show, the security would ignore the excess of fans jumping into the mosh pit, which would lead to the death of ten people.

During the concert, Scott acknowledged fans struggling to breathe and refused to stop the show to help them. This led to an outrage of people who believed Scott should retire from making music. However, he would

acknowledge the incident, showing his remorse for the deceased in a song titled *MY EYES*, on his next album, *UTOPIA*.

Another famous musician, Ye, known professionally as Kanye West, is known for his successful albums *Graduation, The College Dropout*, and 808s and Heartbreak. However, West's fame almost came to an end in 2022 when he began posting Anti-Semitic remarks online. These posts led to West losing his status as a billionaire, and a slew of fans left him due to his prejudice.

Despite these consequences, West has embraced his posts and featured a rendition of the German Iron Eagle, worn by Nazi troops during World War 2, on the cover of his album Vultures. Recently, West posted an official apology to Jewish people, writing the post in Hebrew.

American actor, comedian, and musician Will Smith found himself in trouble after an altercation with Chris Rock at the Academy Awards. The altercation began when Rock made a joke about Smith's wife, Jada Smith. Will Smith then walked onto the stage and slapped Rock. He then worsened the situation for himself by shouting, "Keep my wife's name out your ... mouth!" Two weeks after the event, it was announced that Smith was banned from any subsequent Academy Awards ceremonies.

While not similar to the previous

celebrity cases, popular coffee company Starbucks has seen a boycott for their support of the terrorist group, Hamas. Starbucks has been sending money to Palestine to support Hamas' efforts. This has prompted a widespread boycott of Starbucks causing them to lose billions of dollars. As of December 7, 2023, Starbucks as a franchise lost 11 billion dollars. Starbucks employees have also been boycotting their jobs and not working.

In response to the accusations of their support, the Starbucks CEO stated, "While I am grateful for so much, I am concerned about the state of the world we live in," Narasimhan wrote in an end-of-the-year letter to employees. "There are conflicts in many parts. It has unleashed violence against the innocent, hate and weaponized speech, and lies — all of which we condemn. Cities worldwide — including North America — have seen escalating protests." As well as stating "Our stance is clear, we stand for humanity."

Due to these boycotts, the value of shares of Starbucks dropped 8.2%.

Public opinion has always impacted the actions of celebrities and the overwhelming presence of social media and paparazzi have made the wrong doings of celebrities even more apparent and social media can lead to the persuasion of the public against the celebrity or popular entity.

Hamas and Israel: A Vow to the People

Hamas, sometimes known as the Islamic Resistance Movement, is one of the largest militant groups in control of occupied Palestinian territories.

The Council on Foreign Relations classifies it as a "terrorist organization" that Israel is working to destroy.

To understand the conflict, one must start by understanding the history and significance of the strip of land known as the Holy Land.

The Holy Land is seated on the easternmost end of the Mediterranean Sea and includes religiously significant cities such as Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Tiberius, and Hebron.

Some of these cities are especially important to the three largest Abrahamic religions of the day, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. 55.5% of the world believes in these religions according to Pew Research Center in 2015.

Before the days of the modern world, the Holy Land was ruled by the Jewish populace. However, with the rise of the Roman Empire, they started to persecute the Jews and later, the Christians.

To summarize the history, the Jews tried to rebel against Roman rule and as a result were driven from their home land in an event known as the Jewish diaspora.

After the Jewish diaspora, new

religions began to take hold in the region as the first Islamic Caliphate was founded in 623 A.D. Until roughly the 11th century, various Muslim states began to rule the area under different rulers such as the Seljuk Turks.

However, as Christianity became more and more popular in Medieval Europe, the Christians were frustrated: Their holy cities was occupied by Muslims. As a result, the Catholic church sponsored crusades in the region.

These crusades were a series of battles used in order to retake the Holy Land. However, ultimately, none of those crusades resulted in a Christian victory as the Muslims continued to occupy the region for centuries to come.

For centuries afterward, the Holy Land continued to be occupied by Muslims such as the Ottoman Turks.

After the fall of the Ottoman Empire, the Sykes-Picot agreement came about between the British and the French in order to divide up the fallen empire. This designated the Holy Land as the British predominantly Islamic area known as Palestine.

After World War II when an estimated 6 million Jews were killed in the Holocaust, the Jewish populace wanted their home country back to protect themselves from further persecution and genocide, and as of recent events, it only seemed reasonable.

However, with the announcement of a Jewish state, many of the countries surrounding the proposed boundaries refused to acknowledge their statehood, leaving boundaries ambiguous.

However, to try and settle the

quarrel, the United Nations divided up the Holy Land with two states, Arab and Israeli. Palestine included predominantly the West Bank and similar areas and Israel included the rest.

On May 14th, 1948, right after Israel was formed, Arab states invaded the area in order to reclaim it for the Muslims who inhabited it. Israeli forces held on to the territory with better technology.

As a result, the Arab states seemed to lose more territory as the Israeli military got more and more technology and funding from countries such as the United States.

Today, much of the land that was partitioned for Palestine is occupied by the Israeli military due to the conflict with them annexing the Gaza strip.

Overall, the Hamas conflict is a result of Palestinian radicals turning to militancy and ignoring or supporting acts of terrorism against Israelis. Hamas has engaged in quite the array of unorthodox practices such as kidnapping people and targeting of civilians in acts of terrorism.

A witness testimony was given to CNN: "...Her body was brutalized in a way that we could not identify her,' he added, the trauma clearly visible on his face."

"She said survivors of the terror attack told investigators they witnessed Hamas terrorists perpetrating sexual violence against the victims. She quoted testimonies of several individuals all of whom either directly witnessed sexual violence or saw clear evidence of it," CNN reported.

Recent Teacher Shortages

The U.S is struggling to find qualified educators to teach students. The decrease in teachers is not a post pandemic issue. However, Covid-19 only aggravated the issue even more. According to teachershortages.com, there is an estimation of 55,000 open positions and 270,000 underqualified teachers.

In Tennessee, during the 2021-2022 school year there were 1024 vacant positions, 1672 underqualified teachers, and 64,000 qualified teachers in the state of Tennessee. In that year, the rate of leaving the profession was 7.9%. These will most likely be

will most likely be different in 2023.

In 2019, TASB (Texas Association of School Boards) wanted to figure out why teachers have quit or have thought about

quitting. They sent a poll to their teachers. Their top responses were low pay, stress, disrespect, and student behavior.

This also contributes to why college students do not want to go into that profession. College students have realized the cons of being in the education system and know that they would struggle paying back college loans with their pay.

According to Pew Research Center, in the 1970s, education was by far the most popular degree. 21 percent of degrees were education degrees. In the 2019-2020 school year, less than 4 percent of the degrees were education degrees. College students instead have opted to take business or health classes.

Realizing this issue, Tennessee started the Grow Your Own program. This program helps students who are interested in teaching but cannot pay for college. This program allows people to become teachers through apprenticeship. High school students can start an apprenticeship at 16 and earn a dual enrollment credit. The Grow Your Own program is open to anyone.

States are fighting back against the shortage of teachers by giving raises. In 2023, Governor Bill Lee signed a bill that said that teachers must make at least 50,000 annual salary by the 2026-2027 school year.

The teacher crisis is hitting rural

areas harder than urban schools. East Hickman High School is missing a Spanish and Geometry teacher. However, to fill in the

positions, students use an online program, Elevate K-12. This allows students to learn from teachers in other states and other countries.

Online education in classrooms has pros and cons. Students are able to meet and talk teachers around the world. This could also mean that students could learn different

learning styles and tactics. Students are also able to possibly take classes online that their school does not have. However, there is a downside to online classes.



In the Elevate K-12 program, there needs to be an in-person adult in the room to supervise. This could take planning time from teachers, and it also could put more pressure on them. Having monitors adds further to the cost of having this program.

With an online teacher, students have a harder time connecting with their virtual teachers. Students are not able to talk to teachers outside of the scheduled class.

Another issue is technical difficulties. If there is a technical issue with the website being used or a WiFi connection issue on either end, students will not be able to learn for that period of time.

The struggle to find teachers to teach students is an issue that seems to only continue to grow. If this issue were to grow more, would online education become the new normal?

you need an effervescent movie to cheer you up and make you cry tears of joy, then this is the film for you.



Palworld: The Development and Explosion of Popularity

Palworld is an extremely successful game, initially created with a very small budget by game developers from the Japanese company Pocketpair. This game was initially announced in the year 2021.

To summarize, the premise of the game can be described as *Pokemon* with firearms and no labor laws. Collect "Pals," otherwise known as Pokemon, and use them to fight other Pals or make them work to bolster one's resources. For example, Pals can mine stone, mine ore, cut down trees, gather materials, plant different crops, craft different items, smelt ores, and many other types of actions.

This game was released on January 18th, 2024 on the Steam game store. Only six days later, the game saw its success.

According to statista.com, "Six days after its January 2024 release, role-playing monster-taming game *Palworld* had sold about eight million copies. *Palworld* was released in Early Access on PC via Steam and Microsoft Store, as well as Xbox consoles and Xbox Game Pass on January 19."

This game was created in Unreal Engine, a game engine created by Epic Games that has led to the creation of other games such as *Fortnite*, *Ark: Survival Evolved*, *Borderlands 3*, *Rocket League*, and many others.

As a result of that choice, it is easier for players to create modifications to the game that result in unique gameplay additions. For example, a YouTube user by the name of ToastedShoes created a modification that retextured the Pals into the actual Pokemon models.

However, this modification caused a major controversy in the *Palworld* community as Nintendo stepped in. Nintendo used the Digital Millennium Copyright Act, or DMCA, in order to take down the mod.

As a result of this mod and *Palworld's* recent success, Nintendo has started looking into the similarities between their Pokemon and Pals.

However, as of the current moment, it is unlikely that anything will

come of this situation and as a result, *Palworld* is most likely safe from a potential DMCA takedown.

In the end, good news came from this takedown as more people became aware that you can modify *Palworld* and developers have started to work on many different projects to improve the game drastically.

Despite these troubles, *Palworld* has sold a great amount of games. *Palworld* has made \$215.92 million in revenue according to dotesports.com's estimations.

With an average profit margin for game developers being 2.32%, it is safe to say that *Palworld* has surpassed that margin greatly with their developer revenue, a metric of budget subtracted from their total revenue, at an estimated \$171.3 million.

Overall, despite its limited lifespan on the market, *Palworld* has been a huge success. But why? Why play *Palworld*?

Its similarities to *Pokemon* may potentially play a role. The current generation being targeted, Generation Z and the Millennials, grew up with the *Pokemon* franchise.

As a result, they may think that a more "adult" parody of the *Pokemon* game would be a good way to relive some old memories and make some new ones alongside other fans.

However, even without this nostalgia factor, this game is revolutionizing a genre of games losing popularity every day: survival games. After the Minecraft rush of the pandemic, people lost interest in Minecraft again.

No other survival game stepped up to fill the void that Minecraft left behind. As a result, survival games became stale and repetitive.

However, then came *Palworld*, a survival game with less emphasis on the natural world and more emphasis on the *Pokemon*-like companions you can collect.

People loved the concept. Popular streamers AverageJonas and DanTDM were some of the biggest names to capitalize off of this trend.

Strangely enough, DanTDM used to be a massive Minecraft YouTuber with millions of subscribers back in the 2014-2018 period of YouTube.


Unfortunately, as Minecraft started to decline, so did his channel. However, he very well may succeed by streaming Palworld due to his extensive



In the future, Drake used to want to do something with Mechanics, but he decided to change his path and do HVAC at TCAT.


Drake's hobbies include hunting, fishing, riding four wheelers, playing guitar, and playing football.
